# Direct Mail Guide

Updated February, 2019

## Classes of Mailing

- First Class
  - Stamps or permit indicia
  - ▶ If using indicia, must be greater than 200 pieces
  - Delivers in 1-3 business days
- First Class Presort
  - Permit Indicia or precancelled stamps
  - Must be greater than 500 pieces
  - Delivers in 1-3 business days
- Standard Presort
  - Permit Indicia or precancelled stamps
  - Must be greater than 200 pieces
  - ▶ No guaranteed delivery time
    - ▶ Usually 1-4 days local & 7 days 3 weeks national
- Non Profit Standard Presort
  - Same standard presort but a more discounted rate
- Every Door Direct Mail (EDDM)



## First Class - Non Presort - Stamps

### Postcard Requirements

Height: 3.5" -4.25"Width: 5" - 6"

► Thickness: 0.007" - 0.016"

#### Letters

► Height: 3.5" - 6.125"

▶ Width: 5" - 11.5"

► Thickness: 0.007" - .25"

▶ Weight: Less than or equal to 3.5oz (price varies by oz.)

### Large Envelopes (Flats)

► Height: 6.125" - 12"

▶ Width: 11.5" - 15"

► Thickness: .25" - 75"

▶ Weight: Less than or equal to 13oz (price varies by oz.)

### Non-Machinable Surcharge (Applies on to letters)

- For pieces that do not conform to the machinable letters standard as mentioned above
- ▶ Additional \$0.21 per piece
- Specific criteria are listed in the USPS DMM 101.1.2



# First Class- Presort (Pre-cancelled stamps or indicia)

- Machinable Letters (Envelopes)
  - Height: 3.5" 6.125"Width: 5" 11.5"
  - ► Thickness: 0.007" .25"
  - Weight: < 3.5oz
- Machinable Letters FSM (single or multiple bound sheets that are folded and sealed to form a letter size mailpiece)
  - Height: 3.5" 6"Width: 5" 10.5"
  - ► Thickness: 0.007" .25"
  - ▶ Weight: < 3oz
- Machinable Flats (Large flexible envelopes and other rectangle pieces)
  - Height: 5" 12"Width: 6" 15"
  - Thickness: 0.009" .75"
  - ▶ Weight: < 13oz
  - ► Flats must exceed one of the maximum dimensions(width,height,thickness) for letters
- Machinable Postcards (Single)
  - ► Height: 3.5" 4.25"
  - ▶ Width: 5" 6"
  - ► Thickness: 0.007" 0.016"
  - ▶ Weight: N/A



# First Class- Presort (continued) (Pre-cancelled stamps or indicia)

- Machinable Postcards (Double)
  - Height: 3.5" 4.25"
  - ▶ Width: 5" 6"
  - ► Thickness: 0.014" 0.032"
  - ▶ Weight: N/A
- Non-Machinable Letters (Envelopes that can't be processed on postal equipment)
  - ► Height: 3.5" 6.125"
  - ▶ Width: 5" 11.5"
  - ► Thickness: 0.007" .25"
  - ▶ Weight: < 13oz
- Non-Machinable Flats (Large Envelopes that can't be processed on postal equipment)
  - ► Height: 4" 12"
  - ▶ Width: 4" 15"
  - ► Thickness: 0.007" .75"
  - ▶ Weight: < 13oz
  - ▶ Flats must exceed one of the maximum dimensions(width,height,thickness) for letters



# Marketing Mail (Pre-cancelled stamps or indicia)

- Machinable Letters (Envelopes)
  - Height: 3.5" 6.125"Width: 5" 11.5"
  - ► Thickness: 0.007" .25"
  - ▶ Weight: < 3.5oz
- Machinable Letters FSM (Folded Self Mailer)
  - ► Height: 3.5" 6"
  - ▶ Width: 5" 10.5"
  - ► Thickness: 0.007" .25"
  - ► Weight: < 3oz
  - \*Same pricing as letters
- Machinable Flats
  - ► Height: 5" 12"
  - ▶ Width: 6" 15"
  - ► Thickness: 0.009" .75"
  - Weight: < 15.994oz</p>
  - ▶ Flats must exceed one of the maximum dimensions(width,height,thickness) for letters



# Marketing Mail (continued) (Pre-cancelled stamps or indicia)

### Non-Machinable Letters

Height: 3.5" - 6.125"Width: 5" - 11.5"

► Thickness: 0.007" - .25"

▶ Weight: < 16oz

### Non-Machinable Flats

Height: 4" - 12"Width: 4" - 15"

► Thickness: 0.007" - .75"

▶ Weight: < 15.994oz

► Flats must exceed one of the maximum dimensions(width,height,thickness) for letters



## Every Door Direct Mail (EDDM)

To qualify for EDDM Mail piece must be:

- At Minimum: More than 10.5" in Length OR 6.125" in Height OR .25" Thick
- ► At Maximum: 15" in Length AND 12" High, AND .75" Thick
- Maximum Weight: 3.3 oz.

\*\*Note: To qualify the mail piece must exceed only one of the minimum dimensions but must be within all of the maximum dimensions.



## Types of Postage

### Stamps

Traditional stamps purchased from the post office for First Class mail

### Permit Imprint

- Printed indicia on mail piece or envelope
- ▶ Tells the post office which mail permit to bill postage

### Precancelled Stamps

- Special stamps that come in smaller denominations
- Lower postage denominations are applied to the mail piece and the difference in postage is paid with a mail permit
- ▶ Used only for: Presort First Class, Presort First Class Postcards, Marketing mail, & Non Profit Marketing Mail

#### Metered

- Prints the postage indicia directly onto the mail piece
- Also referred to as "postage evidencing"
- ▶ Third party equipment in which postage is paid to the vendor for the postage printed on the mail piece



### Considerations for Folded Self Mailers

- ▶ If the fold is on the short edge of the mail piece, the fold must be on the right of the mailing panel
  - ▶ The right edge of the mail piece is always the leading edge
- ▶ If the fold is on the long edge of the mail piece, the fold must be on the bottom of the mailing panel
- Can be no more than 12 panels
- Paper requirements:
  - Must be between 40lb and 80lb book or equivalent
- Tabbing Requirements
  - Tabs cannot be perforated
  - Minimum of 2 tabs
  - ▶ 1.5" tab




### Considerations for Booklets

- ▶ If the spine is on the short edge of the mail piece, the spine must be on the right of the mailing panel
  - ▶ The right edge of the mail piece is always the leading edge
- ▶ If the spine is on the long edge of the mail piece, the spine must be on the bottom of the mailing panel
- Paper requirements:
  - <1 oz = at least 70lb book or equivalent</p>
  - > 1 oz.= at least 80lb book or equivalent
- Tabbing Requirements
  - ▶ Tabs cannot be perforated
  - Minimum of 2 tabs
  - ▶ 1.5" tab



# **Tabbing Requirements**

- Cannot interfere with any necessary postage or mailing graphics
- Must be 1.5" non-perforated wafers
- Lead Edge vs Trail Edge:






#### Booklet - Simple Spine (Spine is the bottom edge)

Folded Edge Bottom




#### Booklet - Oblong (Spine is the lead edge)

Tabs 3

Placement 2 on Top Edge - ≤ 1" from lead & trail edge

1 on Trail Edge - centered

Folded Edge Bottom




#### Booklet - Folded (Bound & folded to letter size)

Placement 2 on Lead Edge -≤ 1" from top & bottom


1 on Trail Edge - ≤ 1" from top




# Gluing Requirements

- Can be places as spots or in a line
- ► Glue Spots:
  - Cannot be more than .75" from edge
  - Rule of thumb: One more glue spot is required than the number of tabs required
- Glue Lines:
  - Must span entire edge
  - No more than .75" from open edge
  - ► Thickness can be 1/8" or ¼"
  - Not an option for booklets


